- 1. Flammable and combustible liquids shall be stored within approved cabinets or storage tanks.
- 2. Sources of ignition shall not be located within 18 inches of the floor.
- 3. Ventilation shall be provided as required by the Mechanical Code.
- 4. Means of egress, including lighting, shall be maintained in working order.
- 5. Waste oils shall be disposed of in an approved Class IIIB tank.
- 6. Motor oil shall be stored in an approved Class IIIB tank.
- 7. Gas detection system required if dispensing alternate fuels supplies, such as Hydrogen of non-odorized LNG.
