# **SECTION 3.05. MAYOR PRO TEM.**

At the first meeting of the city council at which the returns of the annual election are canvassed, the council member having the longest length of continuous service on the city council shall be identified as such by the City Secretary and such identification entered upon the minutes of such meeting. Thereafter, such member shall serve as mayor pro tem until the next annual election of officers. Where two or more council members are identified by the City Secretary as sharing the status of having the longest length of continuous service or in the event the council member having the longest length of continuous service on the city council declines in writing to serve as mayor pro tem, the city council, at its first meeting after each annual election of officers shall elect a mayor pro tem from among those sharing such status to serve until the next annual election of officers. As used herein, the term 'continuous service' shall mean uninterrupted service on the city council up to the date of such meeting. The mayor pro tem shall perform all the duties of the mayor in the absence or disability of the mayor, and shall assume the office of mayor for the remainder of the unexpired term in the event the office of mayor becomes vacant. If both the mayor and mayor pro tem are absent from any meeting of the city council at which a quorum is present, the members present shall elect a temporary mayor pro tem to preside at such meeting.



# **EXCEPTIONS TAKEN TO SPECIFICATIONS:**

Clarification: Part 3.0, Section 3.2 - Television Inpsection, par. E.
Distances can be accurately measured in the pipeline starting from the connection to the manhole without interpolation of the manhole depth. The distance measurements could be validated using an over the ground walking meter, or other suitable devices, for accuracy comparison.
Exception: Part 3.0, Section 3.2 - Television Inspection, par. B.
Video picture quality shall be consistent with standard definition video systems. High definition equipment is not cost effective for most projects and therefore is not proposed for this scope of service. Veolia Water takes exception to the possible subjective determination, after the fact, by the Owner's Representative that the television inspection service product is satisfactory or unsatisfactory. This presents unnecessary risk to Veolia Water for submittal of a firmed fixed price per foot (in accordance with the requirements of the RFP) before the fact, and the later subjective determination of product satisfaction. If selected Veolia Water proposes to provide example video footage of picture quality deliverable with proposed line inspection equipment for review by the Owner's Representative. In the event the picture quality is unsatisfactory to the Owner's Representative, then: (1) Veolia Water will adjust the proposed cost per foot for line cleaning and televising to provide enhanced picture quality to the Owner's Representative satisfaction, and (2) the City will limit the quantities of line footage to equal the adjusted cost per foot.



# SECTION 4.02. DEPARTMENT OF POLICE.

There shall be established and maintained a Department of Police to preserve order within the City and to secure the residents of said City from violence and the property therein from injury or loss.

- (a) Chief of Police. The chief of police shall be the chief administrative officer of the department of police. He shall, with the approval of the City Manager, appoint and remove the employees of such department and shall perform such other duties as may be required of him by the city council. The chief of police shall be appointed by the city manager, with the approval of the city council, for an indefinite term. The chief of police shall be responsible to the city manager for the administration of the police department and the carrying out of the directives of the city council. The chief of police may be removed from office by the city manager with the approval of the city council.
- (b) Special Police. No persons except as otherwise provided by general law or this Charter or the ordinances passed pursuant thereto shall act as special police or special detective.
