Mayor McDonald called the meeting to order at 6:03 p.m.

#### Invocation.

Wallace Shaw offered the invocation.

#### Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor McDonald led the Pledge of Allegiance.

#### Consideration of approving the April 5th, 2010 Council Minutes.

On a motion by Councilman Cameron, seconded by Councilwoman Garcia, with all present voting "aye", Council unanimously approved the April 5th, 2010 Council Minutes.

#### Attending citizens and their business.

Tom Pearl of 1710 W. 10th Street complained that the landscaping crew neglects the South side of Brazosport Boulevard, and more lights are needed on Highway 288 at the crosswalk of Brazosport High School to the field house. Mayor McDonald said that TxDot did help them with the crosswalk and agreed more lights are needed.

Mary Seidler of 530 W. Broad announced that she is trying to get a bakery started, and requested a metal container in her back yard. Mayor McDonald advised her that the Planning Commission will be reviewing this issue.

John Stanford of 703 W. 8th Street recently visited a local restaurant and their is a rumor in Freeport that outraged him, as well as them. The rumor is that the City Manager purchased a desk chair in excess of \$3,000. The rumor is also that another senior executive on staff purchased one too. I was a bit concerned about such reckless spending. So, I did a formal open records request to verify whether or not this actually occurred. I was informed today that the Assistant City Attorney had taken this issue before the Attorney General's office for interpretation and that they were going to try to block it, based on "medical." My point is, if we had spend that kind of money for a piece of office furniture for one individual or two individuals, whatever the case may be, I think the Council needs to be aware and the citizens need to be aware of that. In fact I challenge you all to bring this \$3000, or whatever it is, \$3,000 to \$6,000 chair; I've heard both prices. Bring it out here, put it out there, let the citizens see, sit in it, put a prize tag on it so we can see the outrageous spending, if it's true. Now if it's not true, why would we block my request for that information, which should be available under the Public Information Act. Why are we blocking that information? Is there a reason? Mayor McDonald said: "No Sir, not that I know of." Mayor McDonald said he would be looking into that for him. John Stanford stated, "you guys swore to an oath, you have responsibilities as Council members and I would like to see you take it serious, not just wash it under the rug."

### ORDINANCE NO. 2010-2246

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF FREEPORT, TEXAS, CONTAINING A PREAMBLE; CONTAINING FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW; AMENDING THE COMPREHENSIVE ZONING ORDINANCE OF SAID CITY TO CHANGE THE ZONING CLASSIFICATION OF LOTS ONE THROUGH TWELVE, BLOCK SIX, VELASCO TOWNSITE, WITHIN SAID CITY, FROM ITS CLASSIFICATION PRESENT ZONING OF R-3NEW ZONING CLASSIFICATION OF C-2; RATIFYING AND CONFIRMING ALL ACTIONS PREVIOUSLY TAKEN BY THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF SAID CITY OR THE CITY COUNCIL, OR BOTH; CONTAINING A SEVERANCE CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT AND BE IN FORCE FROM AND AFTER ITS PASSAGE AND ADOPTION.

WHEREAS, the City of Freeport, Texas ("the City"), is a "Home Rule City" and a "Home Rule Municipality" lying and situated in Brazoria County, Texas, as described in and defined by Section 5, Article XI of the Constitution of Texas and Section 1.005 of the Local Government Code of Texas, respectively; and,

WHEREAS, Subchapter A of Chapter 211 of the Local Government Code of Texas and Item (g) of Section 3.07 of the Home Rule Charter of the City authorizes the City Council thereof to adopt the provisions of this Ordinance; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City has determined and does here now declare that the adoption of this ordinance is necessary to the health, safety and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City and is necessary to conform the comprehensive zoning plan of the City to the current zoning conditions which exist therein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FREEPORT, TEXAS:

#### SECTION ONE--Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

The City Council of the City makes the following findings of fact and conclusions of law, viz:

First, that the public hearings required by the Zoning Enabling Act of the State of Texas, codified as Chapter 211 of the Texas Local Government Code, and the present Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance of the City, codified as Chapter 155 of the Code of Ordinances of the City, have been conducted in the manner and at the time required.

Second, that not less than fifteen (15) days prior to the date of such hearings, public notice thereof was published once in the Brazosport Facts, a newspaper of general circulation in and the official newspaper of the City, stating the date, time and place of such hearings.

Third, that not less than ten (10) days before the date of such hearings, written notice of the proposed change in classification was proposed and to all owners of property located within two hundred (200') feet of such property.

Fourth, that after considering evidence submitted at such hearings, the City Council of the City is of the opinion and finds that the conditions which warranted the classification of the hereinafter described property as R-3 Multiple-Family Residential District at the time of the adoption of such classification for such property have substantially changed; that conditions now exist which indicate that the classification of such property as R-3 Multiple-Family Residential is no longer appropriate and, considering the community as a whole and the present Comprehensive Zoning Plan of the City, such property should be reclassified for purposes of zoning and the zoning of such property changed from R-3 Multiple-Family Residential District to C-2 General Commercial District.

Fifth, that the health, safety, morals and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City will best be served by the adoption of this ordinance and the change in zoning classification hereinafter mentioned.

Sixth, that this Ordinance in its final form has been reviewed by the Planning Commission of the City as required by Section 32.00.4 of the Code of Ordinances of the City.

# SECTION TWO--Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance Amended and Zoning Changed.

Ordinance No. 1100, read, passed and adopted on the 3rd day of April, 1964, and now codified as Chapter 155 of the Code of Ordinances of the, is hereby amended and supplemented to provide that the following described parcel of land within the corporate limits of the City:

Lots 1 through 12, Block 6, Velasco Townsite of the City of Freeport, Brazoria County, Texas, according to the map or plat of said townsite recorded in Volume 32, page 14 of the Deed Records of said county;

be and the same is hereby reclassified for purposes of zoning as C-2 General as defined in Section 155.038 of the Code of Ordinances and that the zoning of said land should be and the same is hereby changed from R-3 Multiple-Family Residential District to C-2 General Commercial District.

#### SECTION THREE--Ratification and Confirmation.

The City Council of the City hereby ratifies and confirms any and all action taken by the Planning Commission of the City or the City Council of the City, or both, in connection with the change in zoning classification evidenced by this ordinance, including but not limited to the calling of a public hearing required by said Zoning Enabling Act and said Chapter 155, the giving of public notice of such hearings, the giving of written notice to the owners of property which is the subject of such and to the adjoining property owners, the making of preliminary and final reports with respect to such change and the conducting of the public hearings required by said Act and said Chapter 155.

#### SECTION FOUR--Severance Clause.

In the event any section or provision of this ordinance is found to be unconstitutional, void or inoperative by the final judgment of a court of competent jurisdiction, such defective provision, if any, is hereby declared to be severable from the remaining sections and provisions of this ordinance and such remaining sections and provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

#### SECTION FIVE--Effective Date.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.

## RESOLUTION NO. 2010-2226

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF FREEPORT, TEXAS, CONSENTING TO THE CITY OF LAKE JACKSON, TEXAS, ENTERING INTO AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH GULF COAST CENTER FOR CONNECT TRANSIT FIXED ROUTE TRANSIT SERVICE; AGREEING TO THE FORMATION OF THE TRANSIT SERVICES COMMITTEE; NOMINATING JEFF PYNES TO SERVE ON THAT COMMITTEE; FINDING THAT THIS AGREEMENT WAS APPROVED BY A MAJORITY VOTE OF THE CITY COUNCIL AT A REGULARLY SCHEDULED MEETING CONDUCTED IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE OPEN MEETINGS ACT; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Gulf Coast Center, through Connect Transit, will soon be initiating fixed route transit services throughout southern Brazoria County and the Lake Jackson/Angleton Urbanized Area; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lake Jackson is the "designated recipient" for federal formal funding distributed annually by the Federal Transit Administration to small urbanized areas to support the planning, development, and operation of public transportation services; and

WHEREAS, the City of Freeport is one of the stakeholders who has agreed to support its local share requirements of the proposed fixed route transit services.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FREEPORT, TEXAS:

Section 1. That the City Council of the City of Freeport, Texas, consents to the City of Lake Jackson, Texas, entering into an Interlocal Agreement with Gulf Coast Center for Connect Transit fixed route transit service.

Section 2. That the City Council of the City of Freeport, Texas, agrees to the formation of the Transit Services Committee.

Section 3. That the City Council of the City of Freeport, Texas, nominates JEFF PYNES to serve as its representative on said Committee.

Section 4. The meeting at which this Resolution was approved was a regularly scheduled meeting of the City Council of the City of Freeport, Texas, in all things conducted in strict compliance with the Texas Open Meetings Act, Texas Government Code, Chapter 551.

I have attached several letters and documents on this subject property located adjacent to my property TR 50E (0008-0008-000). Through a series of errors your City Contractor, Joseph A. Fischer, for a fee of \$350.00 appraised the wrong property located several blocks away on Ave F.

I have also attached a copy of Chapter 272 of the Local Government Code specifically 272.001 (c) which allows the sale of property which "could not be used independently..." for "...lack of access to public roads;" This chapter provides for the sale to abutting property owners only at less than fair market value. A copy of the 2009, BCAD detail file on this property shows a value of \$450.00, the city paid \$119.90 back taxes for a total of \$569.90 in value. The missappraisal fee should be recovered by the City from its contractor.

I hereby tender my fair market value offer as abutting property owner of \$569.90. Please place this matter on the March 15th agenda for discussion and consideration.

#### Procedure for the Sale of Real Property By a City

Once a city has obtained a piece of real property, Local Government Code Chapter 272 controls how that property may be sold or transferred. Chapter 272 states that the sale of real property owned by a city generally must be accomplished through advertisement of the property and acceptance of competitive bids. Accordingly, if a city wants to sell or transfer a property to a business to promote economic development, the city needs to comply with the requirements of Chapter 272. Specifically, Section 272.001 states:

Before land owned by a political subdivision of the state may be sold or exchanged for other land, notice to the general public of the offer of the land must be published in a newspaper of general circulation in either the county in which the land is located or, if there is no such newspaper, in an adjoining county. The notice must include a description of the land, including its location, and the procedure by which the sealed bids to purchase the land or offers to exchange the land may be submitted. The notice must be published on two separate dates and the sale or exchange may not be made until after the 14th day after the date of the second publication.

There are certain exceptions to the sale-by-bid requirement. Sale of real property by bid is not required if the real property fits into any of the following five categories:

- land that could not be used independently under its current zoning because of its size, shape or lack of access to public roads;
- 2) streets or alleys owned in fee or used by casement or acquired for such purposes:
- 3) land that the city wants to have developed by contract with an independent foundation;
- 4) land that is located in a reinvestment zone that has been designated as provided by law and that the city desires to have developed under a project plan adopted by the city for the zone. 842 or
- 5) land that is owned by a municipally owned utility (under certain circumstances). 141

If property fits into one of the above five categories, it does not have to be sold pursuant to notice and competitive bids. These parcels may be sold through a private sale agreement between the city and an interested buyer. Additionally, property under either of the first two categories may be sold to the abutting property owners only as provided under Local Government Code Section 272.001(c), and the city is not required to receive fair market value for the property.




