The Freeport Fire Department will be hosting Physical Agility Tests on a regular basis as applicants become available. A computer cognitive exam will be scheduled in conjunction with the Physical Agility Test.

The Freeport Fire Department is seeking both highly motivated, proactive, and team oriented Firefighter/EMT's (BLS/ALS) as well as EMT's (BLS/ALS). Freeport Fire Department provides both fire and medical emergency response as well as strives to create and maintain positive public relations and fire prevention to our community. The department offers paid education / training opportunities and fully supports and assists with career development.

The City of Freeport offers Full-Time employees an excellent benefits package including free health, dental and vision insurance for employee, 13 paid holidays, paid vacation and sick leave, education / certification pay, as well as longevity pay.
