Tropical Storm Nicholas Threatening

The City of Freeport Emergency Management team is monitoring the development of Tropical Storm Nicholas. As of this afternoon, Sunday September 12, forecasts are calling for Heavy Rain (8-10 inches) and the potential for Tropical Storm force winds for coastal counties and adjacent marine areas, mainly Monday night and Tuesday. A Cat 1 Hurricane is not out of question, but a tropical storm is currently being forecast.

Please take the time to secure any loose items on your property. Trash service will run as normal tomorrow (Monday), but please monitor communications from the city regarding Tuesday and Wednesday.

This is the time to top off fuel tanks and make sure you have supplies on hand.

Again, the City of Freeport will continue to provide you with information regarding this event as it develops.
